The couple was unhappy because they didn't have a child. They climbed the peak of the mountain and prayed to God. Betara Bromo - God of fire, promised them many children. A stipulation was that they would have to sacrifice the youngest, Kesuma but they hid him instead. An eruption occurred and Kesuma fell into the crater. His voice was heard saying "I have to be sacrificed so that people will be alive. From now on you should arrange an annual ceremony on the 14 of Kesodo."

Kesuma's brothers and sisters held the offering ceremony every year by offering fruits, vegetables, rice, and meats. This ceremony is still held today by Kejawen sects.

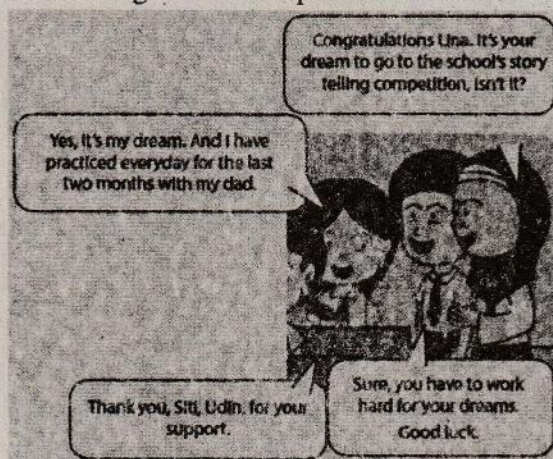
"The tiger is not guilty! He had saved our baby."
